### Class Mass at St. Augustine's Parish Church

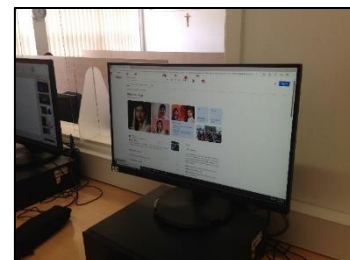

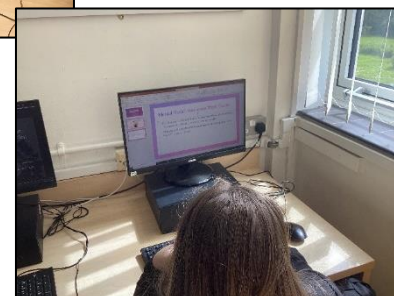
### Wellbeing group

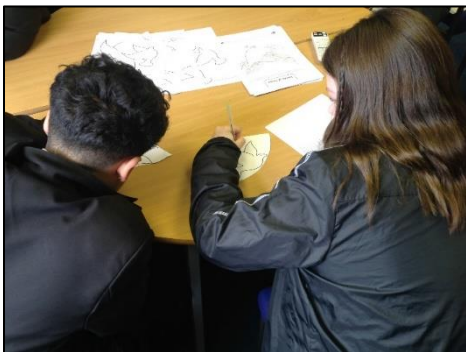


## Liturgy Team

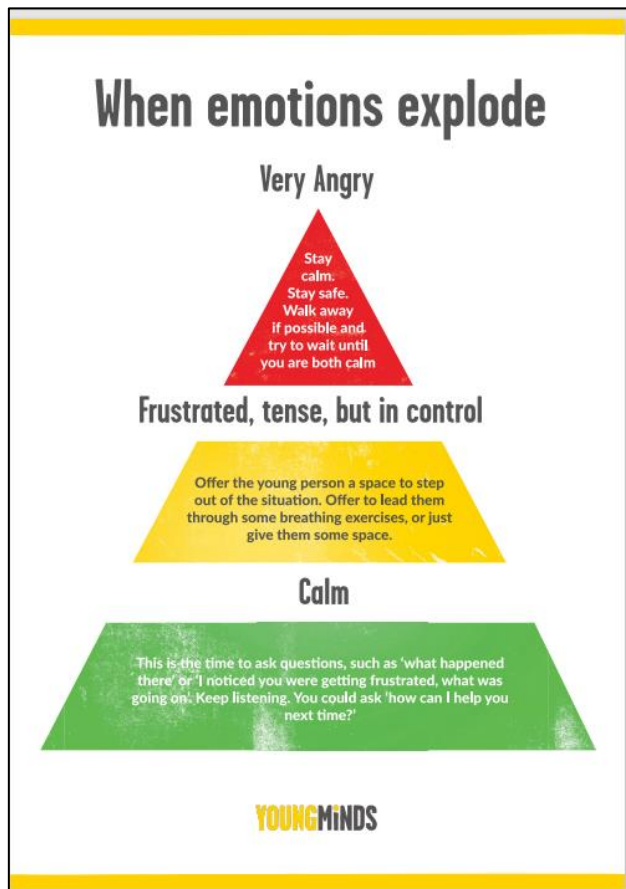


## Wellbeing

Top tips for controlling our emotions:

1. Recognise what is causing you to lose your temper and name the emotion.  
Are you frustrated? Worried? Anxious? Overwhelmed? Labelling the emotion can help you to identify it when the feeling happens again, so that you can use other techniques to help you calm down.
2. Count to ten when strong feelings start to bubble under the surface.
3. Walk away from a situation if you are losing control.
4. Try the 5 senses breathing technique- Find 5 things you can see, 4 things you can hear, 3 things you can touch, 2 things you can smell and 1 thing you can taste.
5. Use a journal to record your feelings. Is there anything/anyone triggering your emotional response?
6. Talk to your trusted adult about this to see if anything can be done to support you.

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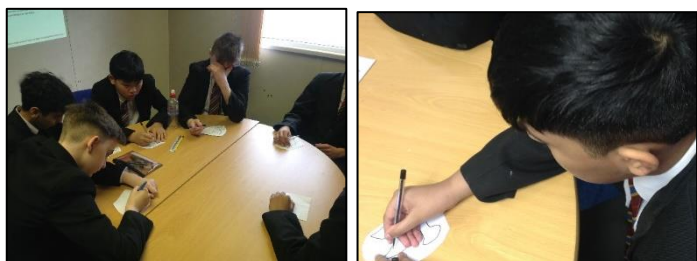
## Departmental News

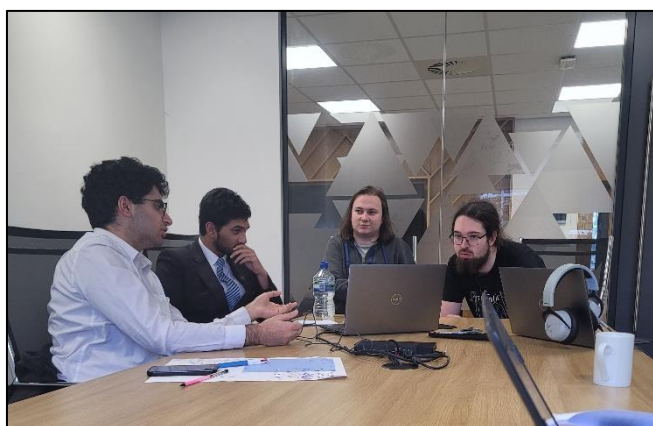
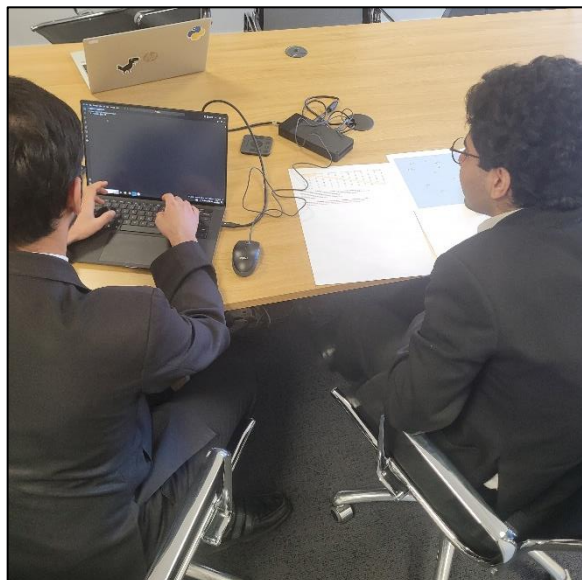
