- To support the Head of Humanities and Languages with leading, managing and developing the subject/curriculum area.
- To effectively manage and deploy support staff, financial and physical resources within the department to support the designated curriculum portfolio.
- To co-ordinate the Quality of Education provided for students in MFL.
- To lead on whole school EAL Quality of Education, including professional development for teachers, monitoring and intervention to ensure positive outcomes for EAL students.
- To liaise with colleagues and external providers to enable students who speak community languages to gain a qualification where available.
