France Trip

A group of 39 Year 8 and 9 pupils enjoyed an unforgettable trip to France from Monday 23 March to Friday 27 March.

The journey began very early on Monday morning, with a 2:30am departure from school. En route to our accommodation at the Château de Grande Romaine, pupils visited the Vimy Ridge Memorial, where they had the opportunity to reflect on its historical significance.

Tuesday was spent exploring Paris. Pupils climbed all the way to the second floor of the Eiffel Tower, took a cruise along the River Seine, and enjoyed a coach tour of some of the city's most famous landmarks, including Notre Dame, the Trocadéro, the Arc de Triomphe, and the Champs-Élysées.

On Wednesday, the group travelled to northern France to visit key battlefield sites, including the Ulster Memorial, Thiepval Memorial, and Newfoundland Memorial. This provided a powerful and educational experience for all involved.

Thursday was a highlight for many, with a full day spent at Disneyland Paris. Pupils made the most of the rides and attractions, finishing the day with a spectacular evening fireworks show.

Throughout the week, pupils also took part in activities at the château, including crepe making and a silent disco, both of which were thoroughly enjoyed.

The group returned to school on Friday evening at around 7:00pm, tired but happy after a fantastic week.

Pupils behaved excellently throughout the trip and were a credit to the school. The experience created lasting memories for everyone involved.

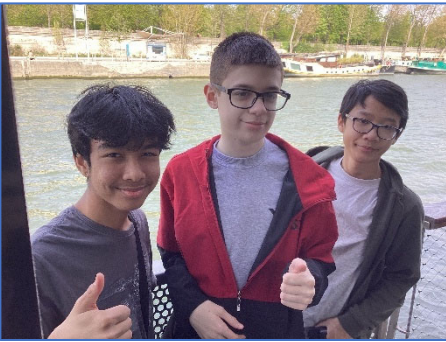
