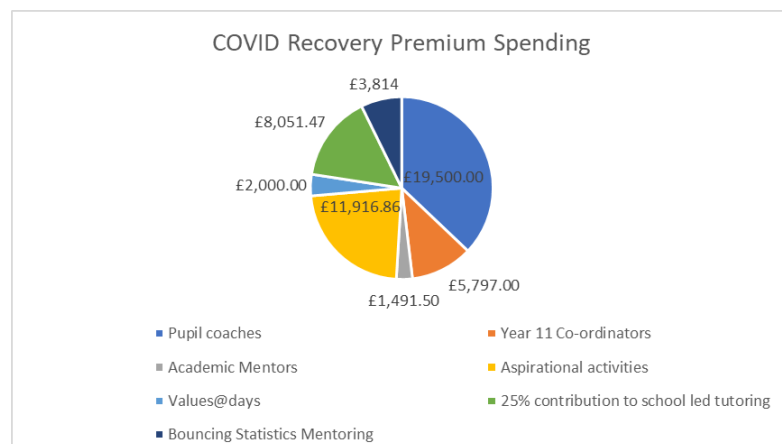




COVID Recovery Premium 2021-22

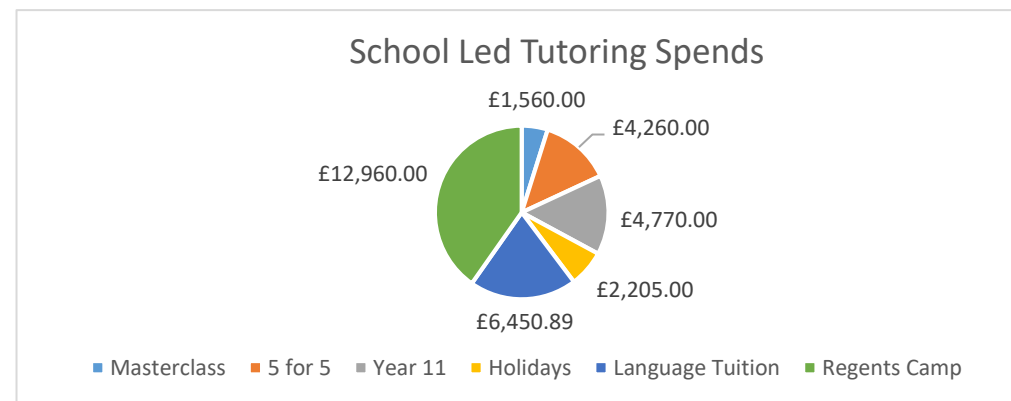
The aim of our spending was to address concerns we identified as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. These included enrichment, attainment and progress, aspirations and motivation and personal development.
