





How has this money been spent?	 Staffing and resources for the St Thomas Aquinas Centre for those students who are not able to access the age relevant curriculum for their chronological age. Subscriptions to learning platforms; Renaissance Reading Programme, Learning Village, Lexia and IXL to support student progress in Literacy and Numeracy. Additional Lifestyle lessons to support those students with low prior attainment in English and Maths. English Mastery programme set up at Key Stage 3 Resources to support learning (e.g. Numicon, FreshStart). Subscription to BEP for support in the Reading Intensive Programme Cognitive Abilities Tests (CATS) and Literacy Assessments Online - these are used to accurately predict target grades for students and identify strengths and weaknesses in the cohort. Subscription to 'Provision Mapping' which allows us to effectively identify, track and evaluate the provision that we are putting in place for our non-secondary ready students throughout each academic year.
