Readers of this book will find out what life as an ancient Egyptian was actually like, both for pharaohs and ordinary people.

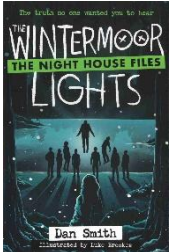

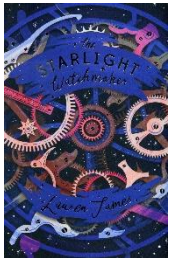

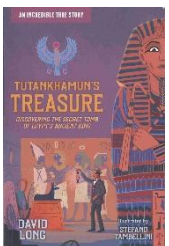

A retelling of the building, sinking and aftermath of the Titanic disaster.

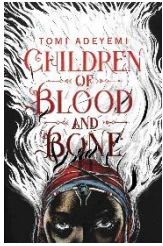

Learn how Howard Carter uncovered the hidden tomb of the young pharaoh Tutankhamun in the Valley of the Kings.

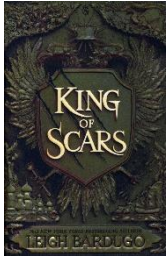

Seventeen-year-old Zélie, her older brother Tzain, and rogue princess Amari fight to restore magic to the land and activate a new generation of magic. Book #1

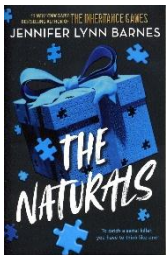

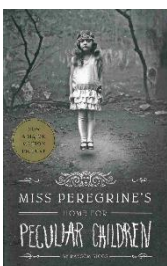
