The successful candidate will lead a two-year project across the two schools, reaching small cohorts of pupils who need high-quality literacy intervention that will enable them to access the mainstream KS3 curriculums on return to their home schools. With relevant teaching experience and qualifications, along with a proven track record of securing excellent progress and relationships with SEND learners, we are seeking to appoint an energetic and dedicated leader who is able to motivate and develop young people, lead and co-ordinate projects, work with teachers, leaders, pupils and parents across different schools and deliver relevant and professional CPD and support packages to facilitate mainstream reintegration.

This is a fantastic opportunity for anyone with a passion for inclusion and a desire to ensure that all pupils have the tools they need to succeed in society, to refine and broaden their leadership skills in a role underpinned by their evidence-based impact on individual pupil outcomes.
