The Role

This role is to assist the Site Manager in maintaining and improving all aspects of the school buildings and grounds. You will help to also ensure that all statutory and other health & safety requirements are fully met.

Responsibilities

You will help to ensure security of school's building and grounds, and manage health and safety of contractors, whilst they are on the school site and to direct them to work as required. Duties will include:

- Opening and locking up the site
- Operation of school systems, including heating, lighting, alarms, security etc
- General porterage of school equipment, furniture and deliveries
- Handyperson duties which may include furniture repairs and decorating
- Maintaining and improving on site safety for pupils and staff.
