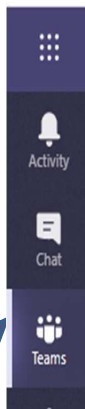

## How do I access Microsoft Teams from home?

1) Go to the School website, click on Microsoft Teams.



2) Down the left side of the screen, click on Teams to see your Lessons.



3) In the main part of your screen, you should be able to see Teams for your subjects. If not, email IT support [ithelpdesk@sjw.bham.sch.uk](mailto:ithelpdesk@sjw.bham.sch.uk)

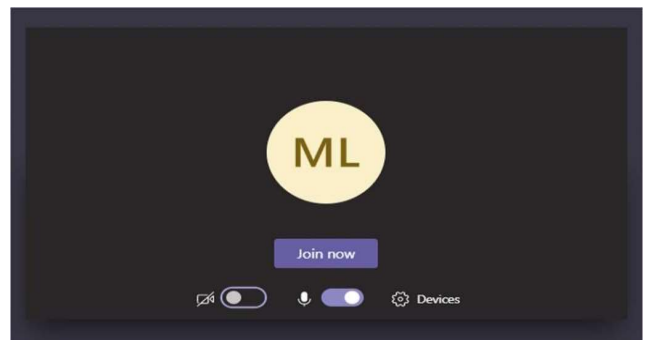
4) Get online around 10 minutes before the lesson and go to the Calendar where you will see it displayed.



5) Click into it and press the join button.



6) When you get to this screen, click 'Join now' to enter the lesson.



7) You are now ready to learn remotely.
